Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to your online application No. EX- 01530-1819 registered on 23.06.2017, on the above subject.

In this connection, I am directed to convey the sanction for extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its **Secondary School Examination** for a further period of **five years w.e.f. 01.04.2018 to 31.03.2023** subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
2. **The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires as per Rule 15.11 of Affiliation Bye Laws.**
3. **The school must follow Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Card for classes VI - IX from Academic Year 2017-18 onwards as per Board's Circular no. : Acad-14/2017 dated 21/03/2017.**
4. **The school must submit it's information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per the Board's Circular no. CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016 dated 10/11/2016 within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in.**
5. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
6. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt from time to time.
7. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under **from Pre-Primary to Class XII**

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.

- (e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows:-

8. The school should scrupulously observe prescription from the Municipal Authority/District Collectorate/Transport Department regarding drinking water, fire safety and transport precautions in the school. A certificate from the Municipal/Fire/transport Authority regarding sanitary conditions, water/fire/transport safety should be submitted every five years as per Rule 8.5 of Affiliation Bye Laws and shall follow Rule no. 3.3(vii) and Rule 23(xi) in this regard.
9. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05

books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.

10. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
11. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.
12. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
13. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
15. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
16. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2 & 3. Also, as per Chapter II, Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, fees charges should be commensurate with the facilities provided by the institution.
17. The school should not engage in **commercialization activities**:-
 - a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.

- b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
18. Teachers are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
19. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
20. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
21. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
22. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
23. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government/Govt. of India. Further, **Salary and Service conditions** of staff should be provided in accordance with Rule no. 3.3 (v) and Rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.
24. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, postal address and e-mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws and upload the same on the website before 15th September of every year. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own **website** containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, postal address and e-mail, telephone number etc.
25. Continuous **sponsoring of students at Board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv), Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.

26. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.

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
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27. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
28. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the '**Persons with Disabilities Act 1995**'.
29. **School infrastructure and teachers for examinations** conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
30. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least **one week training programme** for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
31. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a **Health Wellness teacher** as per rule 53.5.
32. Strict adherence to the provisions of **Wild Life Protection Act** while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
33. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of **private publishers**. The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.
34. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
35. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).
36. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
37. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
38. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
39. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
40. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in & www.cbse.nic.in for updates.

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41. In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye laws of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.
42. **The school shall enter into an agreement with the Board detailing the terms and conditions for grant of affiliation, which will be binding on both the parties.**
43. **The school is required to follow the safety guidelines as issued by the Board vide circular no. 19/2017 dated 12.09.2017 captioned "Safety of Children in schools".**
44. **The school is required to submit Recognition Certificate as per the Section 18 of Right to Education Act, 2009. If the same has not been obtained earlier, the school is directed to apply for recognition certificate immediately and submit the same to CBSE office within a period of one year on issuance of this grant letter.** It must also be noted that further Extension of Provisional Affiliation or Upgradation will not be considered without valid recognition certificate.
45. **The school is required to nominate/relieve the teachers for Evaluation work of Board's Examination every year to avoid any hardship in future.**

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Permission/ Extension of Temporary Recognition has been accorded to the Class (s) VIII(E.M) for the years 2018-2019 in respect of Unicent School, Doolapally, Dundigal Gandimaisamma (M), Medchal-Malkajgiri District in the orders 5th cited. The inspecting authority i.e., the District Educational Officer, Medchal-Malkajgiri District has submitted the report for provisional recognition to the school for the years 2018-2019 to 2027-2028 with reference to the conditions laid down in the permission order/previous recognition orders and G.O Ms.No.1Edn, (PS.2) Dept, dt.01.01.1994 vide reference 6th cited.

After careful examination of the references cited and the conditions prescribed in G.O. Ms. No.1/Edn, (PS.2) Dept, dt.01.01.1994 and based on the recommendations of the DEO, Medchal-Malkajgiri Dist., the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Hyderabad hereby accorded Provisional/ Extension of Temporary Recognition to Class(s) VIII (E.M) for the years 2018-2019 to 2027-2028 in respect of Unicent School, Doolapally, Dundigal Gandimaisamma (M), Medchal-Malkajgiri Dist. subject to fulfillment of conditions as detailed below:

1. That the Educational Society shall abide by the instructions/rules issued by the Govt. from time to time.
2. That the educational Society shall serve the needs of locality more particularly.
3. That the institution shall adopt the curriculum and syllabus prescribed from time to time by the State Government.
4. That the school timings, vacations and mid-term holidays shall be as prescribed by Govt. from time to time.
5. That the qualified staff within age limits prescribed by the Govt. for Government employees shall be appointed as per the staff pattern as per G.O Ms.No.103 Edn (PS), dt.05-08-2005.
6. That the results shall be satisfactory every year and not to be announce the ranks in SSC Public Examinations as per the G.O Ms.No.49 Edn. (PS), dt.26.02.98.
7. That the records/accounts shall be furnished to the D.E.O every year by 31st March, at the latest.
8. That the list of governing body shall be furnished to the DEO every year.
9. That the pay structure / fee structure fixed by the governing body shall be got approved by the DEO every year.
10. That all the conditions prescribed in G.Os and other orders which are not specified in this order shall complied with.
11. That the school shall not be closed without giving notice both the Parents/DEO and competent authority at least (6) months before.

12. That the school shall be closed or permitted to be closed only from the date on which summer vacation is declared.
13. That the society shall submit proposals for renewal of provisional recognition sufficiently in advance i.e., at least (6) months prior to the date of expiry of the renewal.
14. That additional sections/higher classes should not be opened without prior permission of the competent authority.
15. That the recognition is accorded to society and no other society or body can open a school on their behalf.
16. The recognition is accorded to open the school premises in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises or locality.
17. The society shall provide the necessary material even if it costs more than the deposit amount.
18. Admissions should be made on the basis Record sheet issued by the Private Recognized/ZP/Govt/Aided schools only T.Cs/Certificates issued by the Secretary, DCEB as Bonafide candidate.
19. The Edn. Society shall file an affidavit to the effect that there is no deviation or violation of norms/rules prescribed by Govt. from time to time by the end of April every year as per G.O.3rd cited.
20. The above E.T.R. is granted subject to condition that, If it is found later that the school has not fulfilled the prerequisite condition under A.P. Edn. Act 1982, reported by State Level Inspection Team and Vigilance Committee, the E.T.R. now being granted is liable to be withdrawn at once.
21. The Management shall provide sufficient transportation, sufficient fire extinguishers in the school.
22. The Management is totally responsible in all aspects for the safety of school children. They will be personally held responsible if any incident occurs.
23. The Management shall handover the school premises whenever required to this department / Government for emergency purpose (Exams/ Elections etc.) without any deviation of the orders.
24. G.O.Ms.NO.22, dt.18.07.2017 must be compulsorily followed i.e., the weight of School bag not to exceed 4 K.g for VI-VII, 4.5 Kg for VIII -IX and 5 Kg for X.
25. The Management not to run I.I.T. and Medical entrance foundation courses as permission of Renewal Recognition is given only for school.
26. Sanitary & Soundness certificate should be renewed timely and must be submitted to the District Educational Officer, concerned.
27. The Correspondent is instructed to Renewal Lease deed time to time when it's get expired
28. TPF Scheme to be implemented to all Teachers.
29. The Management shall renew NOC from Fire Department from time to time without fail.

The recognition now granted is liable for withdrawal by the competent authority for violating the rule as prescribed in the G.O's cited and instructions issued by the authority from time to time.

7. That the records/accounts shall be furnished to the DEO, every year by the end of academic year at the latest. structure/fee structure fixed by the Governing Body shall be got approved in the order shall be complied with.



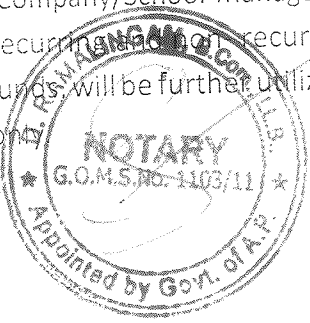

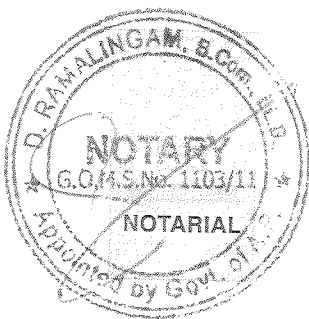
