Introduction to the School

The first Unicent School was established in the Year 2009-10 at Miyapur, while Unicent School at Kompally was established in the year, 2012. Currently we have 5 Campuses - UNICENT SCHOOL-Kompally, Kondapur, Miyapur, Nagole and Bachupally.

- The School is affiliated to CBSE with Affiliation Number 3630156.
- The medium of instruction and communication is English throughout the school. The School is promoted by KBR Foundation which is backed by leaders from different domain expertise including Education, IT, HR and Finance.
- Classes available are Nursery to Grade X.
- Class rooms Equipped with interactive boards.
- Well set Infra Structure with Playground, Labs, Activity room, Teach next lab, Music, Dance, Art Craft room, Library, Indoor and Outdoor sports facilities etc.



Admission Process

- An enquiry form is duly filled and submitted to the counselor at the admissions office.
- Counselor would explain the philosophy of the school and take the parent and child on a tour of the school.
- The student for whom the admission is being sought is to be registered by filling the application from the counselor.
- Written assessment for Grade U.K.G to IX Class would be held. An oral interaction will be taken by the Preprimary Coordinator for a pre primary admission.
- Evaluation of the performance is followed by an interaction of the parents with the Co-coordinators or the Principal to confirm the admission of the Child.
- Applicants selected for admission should confirm the acceptance of the seat offered within 7 working days by remitting school fee and required documents.
- An orientation session is conducted for parents in the month of June.
- Admission process is not complete without the submission of relevant documents.





Please Note the following:

- **Age:** The class age requirement is 3 years for Nursery and 5 years 6 months for class 1 as on 1st April of the Academic Year.
- Classes for which the admissions are Available: Nursery to Grade IX.

Documents Required For Admission

- Two passport size photographs of the student, one passport size photograph of parents.
- Birth Certificate of the child (Pre-Primary to II original & III to IX xerox).
- Bonafide Certificate /Record Sheet in case of admissions below Grade-II and Transfer Certificate for Grades II-IX.
- Marks Sheet (class II onwards) from the previous school attended.
- ID proof of parents.
- Copy of Aadhaar Card details self attested by both the parents and the pupil.
- Caste certificate (for special category).



Introduction to the School

- Unicent places strong emphasis on enhancing subject specific skills in core subjects like English, Math, Science, and Social & Arts channelized to be in line with the Competency Based Education Perspective as guided by CBSE and Ministry of Education. We believe in engaging students in studies through academic activities that inspire inquiry, encourage communication & foster co-operation. The assessments system is so framed that they are evaluated in their Interpretative, logical thinking and competency skills as envisaged by CBSE.
- The Co-curricular Activities offered for the children along with the array of activities the child gets exposed through different IHCs and Assemblies we plan enables the parents to easily understand and discover the true potentials and interests of the child thus facilitate their further enhancement.
- School strongly believes in inculcating the right attitude, perspective towards life, society and nurturing them to be responsible individuals as they
 - grow up, for which they get opportunities in the form of Community linked programs, International collaborative activities, Guest sessions, panel interviews, exposure talks, unique role plays so on..
- The objectives of the School are well embedded into the Curriculum which is revised from time to time bearing the future requirements of the society they need to dwell in. The value system of the school identified by the acronym "ETHICS" is imparted to the children in a structured scientific manner. While one of the major aspects of the Mission of the School of nurturing within them the Traditional values along with scientific temper would be visible through its curriculum and activities involved.







Dealing with students with academic challenges.

- We at Unicent recognize the learning difficulties of the children and we embed special measures in the classroom teaching-learning process, as well as exclusive remedial measures to suit the learning needs of the child.
- Involvement of special educator with regard to the support needed for students with Academic Challenges.
- Counseling the students and boosting their morale from time to time personally by the Coordinators, Principal and use external counseling as per the need.
- Close monitoring of the development of the child through regular interactions with the parent.
- Special focus will be given to the students lagging in basics pertaining to core subjects like language or math.

Our Distinct Features

- Stem Activity: To provide better learning experiences to the students and enhance their scientific Temper, Butterfly Fields/Yard stick a STEM Education based program is incorporated in to the system which is utmost enjoyed by the children adding value to their comprehending and analytical skills as early as from Grade 1.
- **Brainfeed Magazines:** In the context where, kids are seldom engaged with books, are introduced from Grade 4 to 10 is a good source of positive engagement for them, modifying their learning style, which is utmost important to prepare them for a competitive world with an education that is relevant to daily life. The Magazine is also a good tool to help them relate to the world around with suitable topics of their age level.





- Vocabulary Enrichment Program: The focus on Vocabulary Enrichment is another worth to mention feature of Unicent System of Education. Varied opportunities, activities, tasks and competitions are included in the system, in daily and periodic basis for the purpose. This can have an unseen impact on their learning perspective even for the future.
- Projects and Presentations: The term while it could sound common in present day, it takes its place in this column here, due to the intricate process involved in it from the planning level by the teachers. While we strongly believe in providing platforms and contexts for the child to use the RETEACH mode of learning which is most effective as per Edgar Dale's Theory.
- Excursions and Exposure Trips Trips always have inexplicable impact on the minds of young ones that can stay forever. Especially, in the scenario of being groomed in nuclear homes, these trips nurture their social skills along with enhancing their deep knowledge with regard to the topics of interest relevant to the visit. At Unicent these are planned very purposefully interactive and involving. However, outward bound programs are planned only for students above Grade 6 ensuring all the safety and hygiene precautions.



- Learning Exchange programe: unicent school, kompally has tied up with schools abroad for a learning exchange program expanding the global perspective among children.
- ▼ Sports and Yoga: Freehand Exercises/ Yoga are essential elements of the Assembly to begin the day at Unicent apart from having dedicated period slots for the same. Now, in Post-Covid Era, nurturing the little minds with a sensitized approach regarding health and Immunity is extremely crucial. Unicent shoulders the Responsibility along with parents in this Mission.

Competitions: THERE are always two things which can withhold the interest of an individual in it-RELEVANCE and CHALLENGE.

For any aspect to be appealing to a human mind, they need to feel it relevant for them or find it challenging/engaging positively. Communications:

- Parents Teacher meetings (PTM): are held regularly at least 4 times through the academic year. In the event of cancellation of any PTM, the teacher calls the parents of specific students with concern for a discussion while others can seek prior appointment to meet on a Saturday.

Medical checkups will be held twice a Year, with support from neighbouring hospitals.






We take special care to make sure that every child is safe in our hands. The school has been equipped with CCTV cameras. Every bus has a lady helper to attend to the special needs of a girl child.


Regular orientation programmes are conducted in the school for the drivers, helpers and the teachers, which help them to focus on the special needs and safety of every child.
