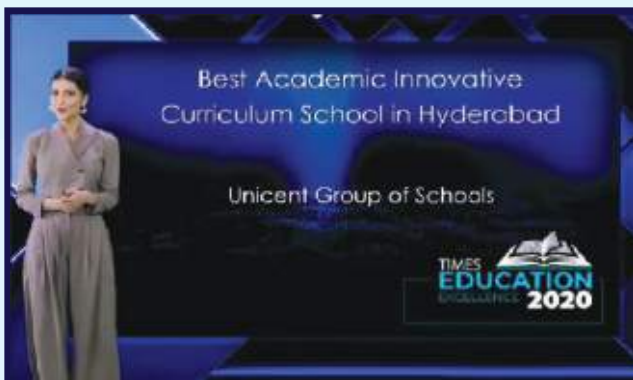

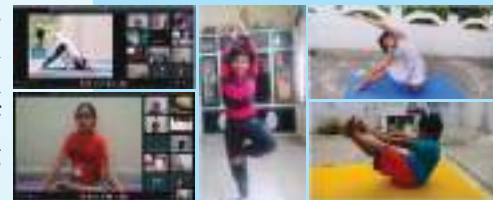

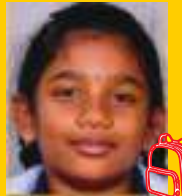

NOVEMBER

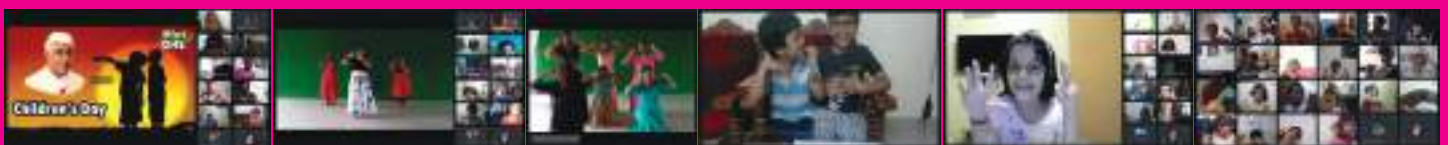
DIYA DECORATION ACTIVITY

SANKRANTHI CELEBRATIONS

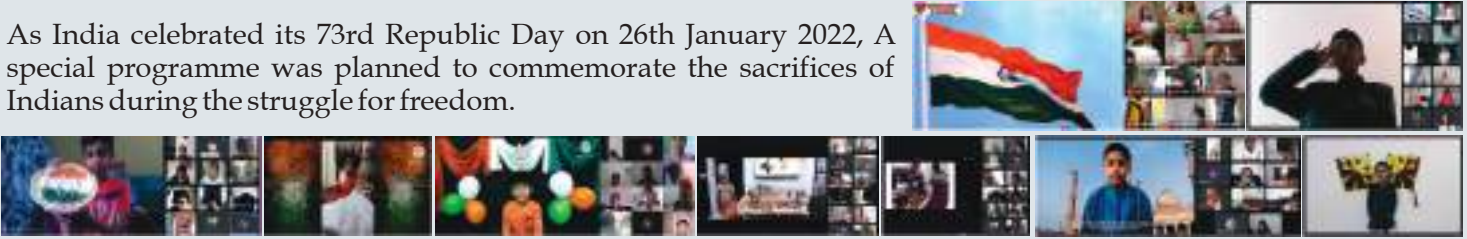
